- \* Adv. Kotwal Sir suggested DLS Affiliation mediation course or training programme.



The Minutes of the meeting of College Development Committee (CDC/LMC) held on 29 Sep 2021.

The meeting of CDC was held on 29-9-2021 at 4:00 pm in the college premises. The following members are present at the meeting. The list is attached.

- ① The Principal of the college welcomed all the members of the CDC.
- ② The minutes of the last meeting held on dated were read & confirmed by the CDC.
- ③ The Principal explained the admission procedure governed by C&T Cell of Government of Maharashtra for law College & stated the admission status of first year of 3 yrs, 5 yrs law courses & also Diplomas run in the college. The committee expressed satisfaction over the number of admissions & the response of the students taking admission to the courses.
- ④ Principal also made a mention of fee structure of college, the proposal sent by the college for 2021-22. The committee noted the fee structure for the new academic year. Hon'ble Sanchitinis Madam inquired about the pending dues of the students who have left the college & expressed the need to take steps to recover the dues. The principal assured that proper steps should be taken by contacting the students & follow up could be

taken under for recovery of the pending fee dues.

⑤ Principal gave the detail report of the curriculum, co-curricular & extra-curricular activities of the college during the last two academic years 2019-20, 2020-2021. The principal highlighted the events organized in the college like National Seminar, Workshops, Guest lectures on various occasion. The committee express satisfaction over inviting the High Court Judges, leading lawyers, Experts in the respective fields. The principal also mentioned about the online activities in the nature of workshops, Lecture series, seminars, webinars during covid pandemic situation from March 2020. The committee also noted the limitation of the college in conducting lectures in corona situation & holding activities.

⑥ The committee noted requirements / funds needed for the coming year reflected in the budget & explained item wise by the principal. The committee approved the budget estimate. Hon'ble sarchitnis madam suggested principal to put up college requirements so as to provide the sanction at relevant time.

⑦ The principal proposed organising of one state level, National level workshop atleast once in a year. Sarchitnis madam suggested to organise even more than one such activities. The proposal was noted & welcomed by the coe & decided accordingly.

Principal discussed the importance of participation of full time teachers in workshop, seminars, orientation or refresher courses of FDP. These participations assume importance in view of the NAAC. The CDC approved deputation of full time teachers as decided by the principal in view of the teaching schedule of the college.

Various drafts such as Vision Mission of college Code of Conduct for teachers non-teaching staff, service rules, etc were submitted for consideration of the CDC. Principal expressed the need for approval of the documents by CDC as the policy matters. All these documents were approved by CDC.

10 & 11 The principal suggested to conduct moot court competitions by the law college. However he explained the financial limitation for holding such competitions as law college run on Non-Grant basis. The concept of endowment plan was also explained by the principal for financial support for such activities CDC member took note of it & assured to discuss this proposal in the Bar Association of Nashik & to take efforts seeking financial assistance for sponsorship & endowment plan.

12 The CDC discussed about organizing Certificate courses in English language & Agricultural Laws for the coming academic year. The proposal put forth by principal was welcomed.

by CDC. Sarchitnis madam emphasized to review the result of such courses for students of our law college to know the benefits of certificate courses. The principal assured that the follow up of certificate course of English language in the next session would be undertaken. Sarchitnis madam suggested to seek the cooperation of principal A.P. Patil sir in certificate course in English language. Adv. Mahesh Aher also suggested to seek the guidance of Adv. Kagh, member of the CDC in coordinating English certificate course. At the end of the meeting Honible Sarchitnis took up the issue of practical training to our law students. She suggested that our students from 1<sup>st</sup> year itself maybe asked to join lawyer's chamber to enrich themselves with the practical aspects of profession. Adv. Joohi, member of CDC welcomed that suggestion & advised the principal to take the assistance from the Nashik Bar Association.

- (13) With the permission of the Honible Chairman of CDC the principal discussed the prospective plans of the college for coming five years organizing state / National level seminar once in a year & organising certificate courses English language / Agricultural law were already discussed in item number 7 & 12. The remaining plans, namely seeking permanent affiliation UHQ course in the college, holding literacy campain on the theme

of arbitration through seminars/literary camps preparing literature on arbitration concepts were also discussed by the principal. The CDC welcomed principal's suggestion as to prospective plan & permitted the college to go ahead with these plans. The principal explained the relevance of these plans for the benefits of law students.

The chairman of CDC Adv. Varnase asked during meeting for the requirements of the college for NAAC. The principal replied to the same queries during the discussion on the items in the agenda of the meeting. The Sanchitika madam suggested to send the proposal expenses towards essential requirements & which need for approval of MVP society.

- (14) Vice principal Prof. C.C. Khairnar offered vote of thanks to all the members of CDC & the meeting was concluded with the permission of the Hon'ble chair.



The meeting of college development committee is conducted on 5th June 2018 at 06.00 p.m. in the premises of m.v.p. samaj's Law college, Gangapur Road, Nashik, under the chairmanship of Adv. Dilip S. Vanarase.

The following subjects were discussed as per agenda and following resolutions were passed :-

- (1) Being the first meeting after constitution of new college development committee, the Principal Dr. Komarai welcomed and felicitated all the members.
- (2) Prin. Dr. Komarai presented the status of admissions in the academic year 2017-18. He explained that due to CET admissions to law courses have reduced this year. And that even granted colleges are suffering due to vacant seats. Vice-principal G.C. Khairnar explained what measures are taken by college teaching and non-teaching staff to increase awareness about CET in prospective students. And expressed the hope to have increase in admissions in A.Y. 2018-19, since large number of applications for CET are received this year.
- (3) Hon'ble Sarchitris Nilimatai Pawar expressed her views about insufficiency of present college premises and assured the committee to give new building for the law college and expressed that this step will make attract more number of students for the course. She requested the committee to visit the building of R.S.M. Polytechnic college and to approve it for law college if found to be suitable. The committee

approved the proposal and fixed 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018 for inspection of the newly proposed building. Committee members directed to see if college can be shifted at the earliest, so that it can positively influence new admissions.

(4) Principal Dr. Kamrai submitted report of CET for law courses. He informed the Committee that college has given wide publicity of CET for prospective students through messenger, pamphlets, hoardings. Committee expressed satisfaction over it.

(5) Vice-Principal C.C. Khairnar informed the Committee about changes in syllabus and exam pattern of law courses. Hon'ble Sarchitris Nilimatai Pawar and Committee members asked to make more emphasis on practical training activities.

(6) About the new building, Hon'ble Sarchitris Nilimatai Pawar enquired whether college can be shifted on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2018 in the new premises. She asked the staff to visit the new building and give report for necessary changes to be made in the building to make it suitable for the law college.

(7) Prin. Dr. Kamrai expressed necessity to prepare for NAAC. Chairman Adv. Vanarase advised to prepare with two aspects - infrastructure and Academic performances. Hon'ble Sarchitris Nilimatai Pawar asked to invite Dr. V. B. Gaikwad sir for guidance for NAAC. The Committee members instructed to do well by preparing in advance, considering the importance of NAAC with respect to college development.

(8) Principal and Vice-Principal presented before

of college. Hon'ble Sarchitnis asked about-

(9) mediclaim policy for students. It was informed  
to the committee that college is already  
taking such policy for each student.

(9) Hon'ble Sarchitnis madam examined  
the fees collection status report and  
called accountant to explain it. She ordered  
to remind students for payment of fees  
and to asked to recover fee due before  
students appear for exam. She instructed  
to do everything necessary to recover the fees.

(10) Principal sir expressed that students are  
facing lower result due to lack of go  
Command over English language. Hon'ble  
Sarchitnis madam asked to appoint one  
full time English teacher and to make  
it compulsory for students to learn English.

(11) Principal sir informed that college will  
apply to University for refresher course  
as per UGC norms.

(12) President- Adv. Vanarase and committee  
members asked to increase the quantity  
and quality of college magazine. All

(12) committee members assured to contribute  
articles.

(13) Principal sir expressed intention to conduct-

career and competitive exam guidance prog. including preparatory classes for JMFC exams. Adv. Kenge suggested to run 6 months prog with help of the Bar. The committee members assured to help in the activity.

(14) Vice Principal submitted report of Curricular & extracurricular activities, like moot court and Legal aid clinic. Committee expressed their willingness to help in Legal aid.

(15) Hon'ble saradhivis madam instructed to create more awareness and advertise for increasing admission as the college needs to increase income. It was informed by Vice Principal that this year fee recovery is good but past dues are required to be recovered.

(16) Regarding placements it was informed to the committee that so far 2 girl students are appointed as JMFC and many students as officers in many other govt & Pvt. jobs.

(17) Principal Kamrai sir expressed vote of Thanks.
